

PREFACE.

I. The earliest edition of Hamlet appeared in 1603, with the following title-page:

The || Tragicall Historie of || Hamlet || Prince of Denmarke || By William Shake-speare. || As it hath beene diuerse times acted by his Highnesse ser- || uants in the Cittie of London: as also in the two V- || niuersities of Cambridge and Oxford, and else-where || At London printed for N: L. and Iohn Trundell. || 1603.

We refer to it as (Q₁).

A copy of this edition belonged to Sir Thomas Hanmer, though he does not appear to have mentioned it in his notes to Shakespeare or in his correspondence, and its existence was not known till his library came into the possession of Sir E. H. Bunbury in 1821. In a copy of the Reprint of 1825, now at Barton, Sir E. H.
